

A Deed of Grant under the provisions of "The Corrected Titles to Land Act of 1882."— County Lot.

BY THE GRACE OF GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and  
Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, and so forth:—

Number and Date of Surrendered Grant No. 41059, dated 30<sup>th</sup> April 1880

Date of Surrender 2<sup>nd</sup> October 1886 to whom these Presents shall come, testifying:

Area of land: one acre.

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the provisions of "The Corrected Titles to Land Act of 1882,"  
Domenico Pedrazzini of  
the Owner thereof, has surrendered to the Crown, All that Piece or Parcel of Land in Our Colony of Queensland,  
containing by advertisement Three hundred and forty acres,  
be the same more or less, situated in the County of Chinchilla  
and Parish of Forbes

Section Ninety-four, described in Deed of Grant No. 41059 dated 30<sup>th</sup> April  
1880

In consideration that a new Deed of Grant with the description hereinafter contained should issue: Now This We, That for the considerations aforesaid, and in further consideration of the Quit-Rent hereinafter reserved, We, with the advice of the Executive Council of Our said Colony of Queensland, have granted, and for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, do hereby Grant, unto the said Domenico Pedrazzini his Administrators and Assigns, subject to the several and respective Reservations hereinafter mentioned, all that

Piece or Parcel of Land in Our said Colony, containing  
Three hundred and forty-one acres and thirty-six perches,  
by advertisement, be the same more or less, situated in the County of Chinchilla  
and Parish of Forbes

Section Ninety-four Commencing at the Southwesterly corner of portion  
One hundred and seven and bounded North on the South by a road  
bearing West Thirty-three chains and Ninety-one links on the West by a  
road bearing North one hundred and Nine chains and twenty-seven  
links on the South by a road bearing East Ninety-one chains and  
Twenty-six links and on the East by a line and portion one hundred  
and seven bearing South one hundred and Nine chains and Ninety-four  
links to the point of commencement exclusive of one acre three  
rods and twenty-nine perches for a surveyed road as shown on plan  
of Survey deposited in the Surveyor-General's Office  
being the land granted under the 1<sup>st</sup> Edition of "The Corrected Titles  
to Land Act of 1882."

with all the Rights and Appurtenances whatsoever thereto belonging: To Hold unto the said  
Domenico Pedrazzini his Administrators and Assigns  
for ever, Yielding and paying therefor Yearly unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, the Quit-Rent of One Peppercorn  
for ever, if demanded: But Subject nevertheless to the several Conditions and Reservations contained and declared in  
the Laws of Our said Colony in that behalf: And we do also Reserve unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors the  
right of resuming for road purposes from the Land hereby granted

being an area equal to that comprised in the closed roads  
included in above-mentioned Surrender, on payment at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_ per acre, being  
equal to that paid by Us for the closure of the said roads, with the right of full and free ingress, egress, and regress  
in and out of, and upon the said Land for the several purposes aforesaid. In Testimony Whereof, We have caused  
this Our Grant to be Sealed with the Seal of Our said Colony.

Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, President of the Legislative Council  
and Administrator of the Government of the Colony of Queensland and its Dependencies, at

day of October in the Eleventh Year of Our Reign, and  
in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-six
