 h. Administrators and Assigns, subject to the several and respective Reservations hereinafter mentioned, All that

Piece or Parcel of Land in Our said Colony, containing
 by admeasurement Three hundred and forty-two acres three rods thirty-six perches
 be the same more or less, situated in the County of Churchill
 and Parish of Forbes. Portion Number-four. Being the Land granted
 under the 1st Section of The Corrected Titles to Land Act of 1882.
 Commencing at the Southeast corner of portion One hundred and seven and
 hundred links on the South by a Road bearing West thirty-seven chains
 and twenty-one links on the West by a Road bearing Thirty-three degrees forty
 minutes three chains and eighty links ten degrees six chains and forty-four
 links Seven degrees five chains and four links and North eighty-eight chains
 and seventy-seven links on the North by a Road bearing East thirty-three
 chains and twenty-six links and on the East by a line and portion One
 hundred and seven bearing South one hundred and three chains and
