Yearly by the State of Govt, at the United Kingdom of Great Britain and  
Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, and so forth.—

Acre 76 acres TO SELL to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting.—

WHEREAS, in conformity with the Regulations now in force for the Sale of Crown Lands in our Territory of QUEENSLAND,

Eliza Bambury

becomes the Purchaser of the Land hereinafter described, for the sum of One pound fifteen shillings  
Sterling: Plus Rent etc. That he and in consideration of the said Sum, for and on Our behalf well and truly paid into the Colonial Treasury of Our said Territory, before these Presents are issued, and in further consideration of the Quit-Rent hereinafter Reserved, We, with the advice of Our Executive Council of QUEENSLAND, HAVE GRANTED, and for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, Do HEREBY GRANT unto the said Eliza Bambury

and respective Reservations hereinafter mentioned, AND THAT Piece or Parcel of Land in Our said Territory, containing by Admeasurement Seventy six acres  
to the same more or less, situated in the County of Churchill  
and Parish of Waller

Selection one thousand seven hundred and seventy six acres  
Ipswich district portion four hundred and forty six.  
commencing on a road one chain wide at the west corner of portion four hundred and thirty three and  
bearing thence on the southward by that road bearing  
one hundred and thirty degrees thirty nine minutes  
nineteen chains and forty links on the northwest by  
portion four hundred and forty seven and four hundred  
and twenty seven bearing sixty degrees thirty minutes thirty  
nine chains and fifty three links on the northward by  
a line bearing one hundred and fifty degrees fifteen  
minutes nineteen chains and forty six links and on the  
southeast by a line and portion four hundred and  
thirty three bearing two hundred and forty degrees  
Ninety minutes thirty nine chains and sixty seven links  
to the point of commencement Being the Land  
purchased under the 7<sup>th</sup> Section of the Crown Lands  
Alienation Act of 1863.

with all the Rights and Appurtenances whatsoever thereto belonging; To hold unto the said Eliza Bambury  
for ever, Tenning and Paying therefor Yearly unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, the Quit-Rent of One Peppercorn

for ever, if demanded: Provided Further, AND WE DO HEREBY RESERVE unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all such parts and so much of the said Land as may hereafter be required for making Public Ways, Canals, or Railroads, in, over, and through the same, to be set out by Our Governor for the time being of Our said Territory, or some person by him authorized in that respect; AND ALSO, all Sand, Clay, Stone, Gravel, and indigenous Timber, and all other Materials, the natural produce of the said Land, which may be required at any time or times hereafter for the construction and repair of any Public Ways, Bridges, Canals, and Railroads, or any Fence, Embankments, Dams, Sewers, or Drains necessary for the same, together with the right of taking and removing all such Materials; AND WE DO HEREBY FURTHER RESERVE unto Us, our Heirs and Successors, the right of full and free ingress, egress, and regress, into, out of, and upon the said Land, for the several purposes aforesaid. In Testimony Whereof, We have caused this Our Grant to be Sealed with the Seal of Our said Territory.

WITNESS Our Trusty and Well-beloved SIR ARTHUR EDWARD KENNEDY, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Queensland and its Dependencies, at Government House, Brisbane, in QUEENSLAND aforesaid, this Twenty-fourth day of December in the Ninety-first Year of Our Reign, and in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.
