WHEREAS, in conformity with the Regulations now in force for the Sale of Crown Lands in our Territory of QUEENSLAND Richard Mason

Stirling: Now Know Ye, That for and in consideration of the said sum for and on Our behalf well and truly paid into the Colonial Treasury of Our said Territory, before these Presents are issued, and in further consideration of the Quit-Rent hereinafter Reserved, We, with the advice of Our Executive Council of QUEENSLAND, HAVE GRANTED, and for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, Do HEREBY GRANT unto the said

Richard Mason

his Heirs and Assigns, Subject to the several

and respective Reservations hereinafter mentioned, ALL THAT

Piece or Parcel of Land in Our said Territory,
containing by Admeasurement one hundred and forty one acres
be the same more or less, situated in the County of Churchill
and Parish of Wallcoo Selection 3257 Special District Portion six hundred
and fifty three commencing at the South corner of portion six hundred and
fifty four and bounded thence on the North by that portion bearing thereon
one hundred and twenty two degrees thirty minutes Sixty five chains and eighty six
links on the Northwest by a line bearing two hundred and thirty seven degrees
three minutes twenty nine chains and forty four links on the Southwest by
line bearing one hundred and nineteen degrees forty five minutes eight
chains and sixty four links one hundred and twenty seven degrees
forty five minutes six chains and eighty links eighty eight degrees
fifteen minutes four chains and ninety links one hundred
and twenty degrees forty five minutes nine chains and thirty seven
links one hundred and sixty three degrees forty five minutes four
chains and twenty links and two hundred and thirty three
degrees 50' 60" chains and thirty eight links by portion four hundred and
sixty bearing one hundred and forty two degrees fifty five
minutes twenty one chains and by portion three hundred and thirty
six bearing one hundred and forty two degrees thirty nine minutes twenty four

for ever, TENEMENT and Paling therefor Yearly unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, the Quit-Rent of One Peppercorn, for ever, if demanded; PROVIDED nevertheless, AND WE DO HEREBY RESERVE unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all such parts and so much of the said Land as may hereafter be required for making Public Ways, Canals, or Railroads, in, over, and through the same, to be set out by Our Governor for the time being of Our said Territory, or some person by him authorized in that respect; AND ALSO, all Sand, Clay, Stone, Gravel, and Indigenous Timber, and all other Materials, the natural produce of the said Land, which may be required at any time or times hereafter for the construction and repair of any Public Ways, Bridges, Canals, and Railroads, or any Fences, Embankments, Dams, Sewers, or Drains necessary for the same, together with the right of taking and removing all such Materials; AND WE DO HEREBY FURTHER RESERVE unto Us, our Heirs and Successors, the right of fell and free ingress, egress, and regress, into, out of, and upon the said Land, for the several purposes aforesaid. In Testimony whereof, We have caused this Our Grant to be Sealed with the Seal of Our said Territory.
